Qualifications

You have an MD and you should be interested in prostate cancer epidemiology and be able to plan and execute clinical cancer studies by use of register data. You are proficient in spoken and written English and have good communication skills. The project involves comprehensive statistical analyses including advanced state transition modelling in order to predict long term outcomes for men with low-risk prostate cancer.

Proficiency in epidemiology and statistics and proficiency in use of STATA and 'R' is a requirement. Expertise in clinical prostate cancer diagnosis, treatment, and follow-up is also necessary.
